A WONDERFUL SAVIOR

(Matthew 1:18 – 25)

INTRODUCTION - What is it that makes Jesus so wonderful, distinctive, set apart?

1. THE MANNER OF HIS BIRTH: (text)

This puts Jesus in a class by Himself.

An earthly child with a heavenly Father, a heavenly child with an earthly mother.

2. HE LIVED A WONDERFUL LIFE

(Hebrews 4:15) "was in all points tempted as we are, yet **without sin.**"

Pilate concluded: (Luke 23:4) "I find **no fault in this Man.**"

(1 Peter 2:22) "Who **committed no sin**, nor was deceit found in His mouth."

No one ever has lived, is living, nor will ever live like that.

3. HE DIED A VICARIOUS DEATH

"Vicarious" - serving instead of someone else; a Divine substitute.

(Romans 5:6-8) "... Christ died for the ungodly ... Christ died **for us.**"

(1 John 4:10) "... and sent His Son to be the propitiation **for our sins.**"

4. HIS PURPOSE-FILLED RESURRECTION

(Romans 4:25) "Who was delivered for our offenses, and **was raised** for our justification"

(1 Cor. 15:17) "and if Christ is not risen, your faith is futile; you are yet in your sins."

5. HIS ASCENSION TO HEAVEN: (Acts 1:9-11)

(Ephesians 1:20-23) "which He worked in Christ when **He raised Him from the dead** and **seated Him at His right hand** in the heavenly places ... "

(Colossians 3:1) "... seek those things which are above, **where Christ is**, sitting at the right hand of God"

6. HE'S COMING BACK: (Acts 1:11)

(John 14:1-3; 2 Thessalonians 1:7-10)

7. HIS WONDERFUL (GRACIOUS) INVITATION

(John 1:17) "the law was given through Moses, grace and truth came through Jesus Christ"

(Matthew 11:28-29) "**Come to Me**, all you who labor and are heavy laden,
and I will give you rest ... and **you will find rest for your souls**"
