IN NEED OF PRAYER

(1 Timothy 2:1-8)

INTRODUCTION

(1 Sam. 12:23) "God forbid that I should sin against the Lord in ceasing to pray for you"

Use your Directory or the Bulletin's Prayerfully Remember list.

1. (1 Tim. 2:2) "... for all that are in authority ... "

Pray for leaders in other countries that they make decisions that will lead to peace for all.
Pray for our missionaries and brethren who worship in war-torn places.

2. For the Christian who repents.

Samuel prayed when Israel repented: (1 Sam 7:5) "I will pray for you unto the Lord"
(James 5:16) "Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another"

3. For the sick: (3 John v1-2; 2 Cor. 12:7-9) for another's illness and our own.

4. For our unity: (John 17:9, v20-21) "I pray for them" "That they all may be one"

(Eph. 4:3; Psalm 133:1-2)

5. For all the saints:

Are you praying for someone? Let it be known in the Bible class, worship assembly,
foyer, parking lot, and with cards, calls, and visits.
(Philippians 1:3-4) and (Col. 1:3) "praying always for you"

6. For the preacher.

(Eph. 6:18) "praying always with all prayer ... (v19) "and for me ... "

7. For those with an uncommon anxiety:

(Phil. 4:6) "Be careful (anxious) for nothing; but in everything by prayer and
supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God"

8. For others to be saved.

(1 Timothy 2:1) "prayers" (v2-3) "For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God
our Savior; who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge
of the truth"
