"THAT YOUR PRAYERS BE NOT HINDERED"

(Luke 18:9-14)

- 1. PRIDE / SELF-RIGHTEOUS (Luke 18:9-14) "Two men went up to the temple to pray ...
 This man went down to his house justified rather than the other"
- 2. (Prov. 21:13) "Whoso stops his ears at the cry of the poor, he also shall cry himself, but shall not be heard."
- 3. WILLFUL SIN / DISOBEDIENCE

(Isaiah 59:1-2) "... your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear."

(Prov. 28:9) "He that turns away his ear from hearing the law, his prayer shall be abomination"

(Prov. 15:29) "The Lord is far from the wicked: but he hears the prayer of the righteous"

(1 Peter 3:12) "For the eyes of the Lord are over the righteous, and his ears are open unto their prayers: but the face of the Lord is against them that do evil"

(Psalm 66:18) "If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear me"

- 4. DOUBT (James 1:5-8) "let him ask of God ... nothing doubting"
- 5. FAILURE TO ASK (James 4:2) "Ye have not, because ye ask not"
- 6. SELFISHNESS (James 4:3) "Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts"
- 7. UNFORGIVING ATTITUDE (Matt. 6:12) "Forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors" (v14-15) "if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses"
- 8. NEGLECT / DO NOTHING (Col. 4:2) "Continue in prayer, and watch ... "
 (Matt. 26:41) "Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation ... "
- 9. FAMILY RELATIONSHIPS (1 Peter 3:7) "... that your prayers be not hindered"
- 10. LACK OF PERSISTENCE (Luke 11:5-8) (Luke 18:1; Rms. 12:12; 1 Thess. 5:17)
- 11. TO BE SEEN BY OTHERS / VAIN REPETITIONS (Matt. 6:5-7)
- CLOSE God answers prayers! The answer may be: "Yes" "No" "Wait" "Here's something better than what you requested" "My grace is sufficient" or "I'll sent an angel to strengthen you"
