"ONE ANOTHER" SERMONS: REVIEW

INTRODUCTION

"One" - I; me; it's personal; individual; it's you and it's me.

"Another" - the one beside(s) you; other than you; all others in the congregation.

(Romans 1:7-12) "... First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for you all ... without ceasing I make mention of you always in my prayers ... For I long to see you, that I may impart unto you some spiritual gift ... that I may be comforted together with you by the mutual faith both of you and me."

Very few of the "one another" verses may be carried out in the worship assembly alone. We must also go outside the assembly in order to put God's "one another" plan to practical use.

THE LIST OF "ONE ANOTHER" VERSES USED IN THESE SERMONS

(John 13:34) "that ye love one another"

(1 John 4:7) "Beloved, let us love one another"
"Love" - not merely thinking or feeling; it's a choice; one chooses to be benevolent to another; a display or demonstration of regard for another; charity.

(Romans 12:5) "one body ... members one of another" - (1 Cor. 12:12-27)

(Rms. 12:10) "Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honor preferring one another."

(Rms. 12:15-16) "rejoice ... weep ... Be of the same mind one toward another"

(Rms. 14:13) "Let us not judge one another any more: but judge this rather ... "

(Rms. 14:19) "and things wherewith one may edify another"

(Rms. 15:5-7) "be like-minded one toward another according to Christ Jesus ... receive ye one another, as Christ also received us to the glory of God"

(Rms. 15:14) "able also to admonish one another" - admonishing seeks to restore.

5 pre-requisites to "admonish" are "full of goodness" and "filled with all knowledge" and in (Gal. 6:1) "ye which are spiritual" "in the spirit of meekness" "considering thyself"

(Rms. 16:16) "Salute one another with a holy kiss" - whatever the greeting, make it pure.

(1 Cor. 4:6) "that no one of you be puffed up for one against another"

(1 Cor. 11:33-34) "tarry one for another"

(1 Cor. 12:25) "but that the members should have the same care one for another"

(Gal. 5:13) "by love serve one another"

- (Gal. 5:15) "but if ye bite and devour one another, take heed that ye be not consumed one of another"
- (Gal. 5:26) "Let us not be desirous of vain glory, provoking one another, envying one another"
- (Gal. 6:2) "Bear ye one another's burdens"
- (Eph. 4:1-2) "forbearing one another in love"
- (Eph. 4:30-32) "be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another"
- (Eph. 5:21 6:9) "Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God"
 - The application of "submitting" is made in 8 areas: (5:21) "one to another" (v22) "wives" (v25) "husbands" (v32) "church" (6:1) "children" (v4) "fathers" (v5) "servants" (v9) "masters"
 - In life, we will never reach an age wherein you do not submit to something or someone: submit to nature (gravity, weather, etc.), civil law, employer, rights of others, and ultimately all will submit to Jesus in judgment.
- (Col. 3:9) "Lie not one to another"
 - Related texts: (Psalm 63:11 and 109:2; Prov. 4:24 and 6:16-19; Eph. 4:25, v29) 4 exhortations: (Rev. 21:8, 22:15) Do not make a lie. (Mark 4:24) Do not take a lie. (Matt. 12:36) Do not repeat a lie. (Rev. 21:8, 22:15) Do not love a lie.
- (Col. 3:16-17) "teaching and admonishing one another in psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs, singing ... " (also Eph. 5:19-20)
- (1 Thess. 4:18) "comfort one another with these words" (also 1 Cor. 15:13-19)
- (1 Thess. 5:11) "Wherefore comfort yourselves together, and edify one another"
- (Hebrews 3:12-13) "But exhort one another daily" (Hebrews 10:23-25) "let us consider one another ... exhorting one another"
- (1 Peter 3:8-9) "having compassion one of another"
- (1 Peter 4:8-10) "Use hospitality one to another ... even so ministering the same one to another"
- (James 4:11-12) "Speak not evil one of another, brethren"
- (James 5:9) "Grudge not one against another, brethren"
- (James 5:16) "Confess your faults one to another and pray one for another"
- (1 John 1:6-7) "we have fellowship one with another"
- CLOSE God have given us a long list of "one another" verses that must not be ignored if we (the church) are to shine forth as beacons on a hill. The spiritual light of individual Christians will become brighter to the world as more of God's "one another" plan works in us.
