NAMES FOR US AS INDIVIDUALS

- INTRODUCTION these words describe our relationship to one another, or to God, or to our task in Christian living.
- 1. (Acts 11:26) "... and the disciples were called Christians first at Antioch."

"Disciple" - learner, student, imitator of the Master, follower. (Matt. 10:1 and 11:1; John 8:31; Acts 9:1; Acts 20:7)

2. (1 Tim. 4:12) "... but be thou an example of the believers ... "

"Believer" - to have been persuaded; trusting; yielding; obedient; commitment. (Acts 2:44; Acts 5:14; Acts 8:12)

3. (1 Cor. 1:2) "Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours."

"Saints" - sanctified; one who is set apart from the world in devotion to service to God; one appointed to a service designated by God; Christians.

The "saints" became such while living: (Acts 9:13, v32; Rms. 1:7; 2 Cor. 1:1; Eph. 4:12; Phil. 1:1; Col. 1:2)

4. (Rms. 12:4) "For as we have many members in one body ... "

(Col. 1:18) "And he is the head of the body, the church ... "
"Member" - one the individuals composing a group; belong to; one of the whole.

5. (1 John 3:1-2) "Behold, what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called the sons of God ... "Beloved, now we are the sons of God ... "

"Sons" - in the family; one of the children. (Romans 8:14-17; Gal. 3:26-27; Eph. 5:1)

- 6. (Matt. 23:8) "But be ye not called Rabbi: for one is your Master, even Christ; and all ye are **brethren.**" (v9) "And call no man your father upon the earth: for one is your Father, which is in heaven."
- 7. (Acts 11:26) "... and the disciples were called Christians first at Antioch"

"Christian" - to be Christ-like. This is a God-appointed name: (Isa. 55:5; Isa. 62:2; Acts 26:28; 1 Peter 4:16)
