**THE TRANSFIGURATION OF JESUS** (Matthew 17:1-8)  
(Mark 9:2-8; Luke 9:28-37; 2 Peter 1:16-21)

(v1) "Jesus took Peter, James, and John his brother"

These 3 are with Jesus when raising Jarius' daughter (Luke 8:51), and  
with Him in the Garden of Gethsemane (Matthew 26:37).  
It's Peter's voice recorded in (Acts 2:14), James is a martyr (Acts 12:20),  
and John is described as "the disciple whom He loved (John 19:26).

(v1) "led them up on a high mountain by themselves"

(Luke 9:28) "went up to the mountain to pray"

(Luke 9:29) "As He prayed, the appearance of His face was altered"  
(Matthew 17:2) "and He was transfigured before them"

(Matt. 17:2) "His face shone like the sun, and His clothes became as white as light"  
(Mark 9:3) "His clothes became shining, exceeding white, like snow ... "  
(Luke 9:29) "and His robe became white and glistening"

(Matthew 17:3) "And behold, Moses and Elijah appeared to them, talking with Him"

Moses, here 1500 years after his death, is known for receiving the commandments.  
Elijah, here 1000 years later, having been translated, is representative of the prophets.  
They stand with Jesus.

(Luke 9:30 – 31) "two men talked with Him ... spoke of His decease ... "

Jesus died voluntarily: (Matthew 16:21, 17:22-23, 20:18-19, 26:32)  
Apostle Paul spoke of his "departure is at hand" in (2 Timothy 4:6).  
Peter said, "have a reminder of these things after my decease" in (2 Peter 1:15).  
We should talk about ours: (Hebrews 9:27) "It is appointed for men to die once,  
but after this the judgment."

(Luke 9:32) "Peter and those with him were heavy with sleep ... when fully awake ... "

(Luke 9:33) "as they were parting from Him, Peter said to Jesus, Master, it is good  
for us to be here; and let us make three tabernacles: one for You, and  
one for Moses, and one for Elijah, not knowing what he said."

(Matthew 17:5) "While he was still speaking, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them;  
and suddenly a voice came out of the cloud, saying, This is My beloved Son,  
in whom I am well pleased. Hear Him."

(v8) "when they lifted up their eyes, they saw no one but Jesus only"
