"THINK ON THESE THINGS"

- INTRODUCTION (Philippians 4:8) (KJV) "Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things."
- "Think" meditate; consider; give serious thought; ponder; think in a particular way.
- What is the reasoning for giving this list? Because of "anxiety" in their life, Paul provides a remedy that includes (v4) "Rejoice in the Lord" (v6) "prayer" and (v8) "these things" and this would bring a "peace that passes understanding."

Do not allow your "anxiety" to take you out of service.

When you cannot change your circumstances, change your attitude.

"THINK ON THESE THINGS" - make it a personal application.

- 1. "TRUE" primarily unconcealed; manifest; exactly as appears or claimed; authentic; actual or true to fact (and not merely as a possibility).
 - 1) Think about God: (John 7:28; 1 Thessalonians 1:9); Hebrews 6:18)
 - 2) Think about Jesus: (John 12:49; John 14:6)
 - 3) Think about the Godhead and truth: (John 16:13-14)
 - 4) (2 Timothy 3:14-16)
- 2. "HONEST" be ethical; conduct as deserves esteem; honorable.
- 3. "JUST" in accordance with right; doing that which frees you from guilt or blame.
- 4. "PURE" kept from defilement; chaste. (1 Peter 1:22; 2 Cor. 3:16-17)
- 5. "LOVELY" that which is attractive or pleasing; seeking the welfare of others.
- 6. "GOOD REPORT" behave yourself. (Romans 14:7)
- 7. "ANY VIRTUE" moral goodness or excellence. (2 Peter 1:5)
- 8. "PRAISE" commendation; compliment; so speak praise of; to bless.
- CLOSE (v9) "The things which you learned and received and heard and saw in me, these things do, and the God of peace will be with you."
