## WISDOM DEMONSTRATED

(Matthew 7:21-29)

INTRODUCTION - (James 3:13) "Who is wise and understanding among you? Let him show by good conduct that his works are done in the meekness of wisdom."

"Wisdom / wise" - understanding; a right use of the mind; to perceive or acknowledge.

The Bible gives praise to "wisdom" - (Job 28:17-18) "... for the price of wisdom is above rubies" (Ecclesiastes 9:16) "Wisdom is better than strength" (Proverbs 3:13-15) "Happy is the man who finds wisdom ... "

## 4 MARKS OF SPIRITUAL WISDOM

1. FEAR GOD - (Proverbs 9:10) "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding"

"Fear of the Lord" is defined in 3 ways: 1) Be in awe of God (Psalm 33:8) "Let all the earth fear the Lord; let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him"

2) To exercise caution on our part (Proverbs 3:7) "Do not be wise in your own eyes, fear the Lord and depart from evil"

3) To really tremble (Hebrews 10:30-31)

"... It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God"

(Proverbs 1:7) "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction"

2. OBEY GOD - (Ecc. 12:13-14) "... Fear God and keep His commandments ... "

(Psalm 128:1) "Blessed is every one who fears the Lord, who walks in His ways"

Jesus identifies "wisdom" to this mark: (Matthew 7:24) "Therefore whoever hears these words of Mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man ... "

(James 1:22) "be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves"

3. WIN SOULS (OTHERS) TO GOD - (Proverbs 11:30) "... he who wins souls is wise"

(2 Cor. 5:11) "Knowing, therefore, the terror of the Lord, we persuade men ..."

(James 5:18-19) and (Mark 16:15-16) - reach out to others with a soul-saving message.

## 4. PREPARING TO MEET YOUR GOD

In life, we recognize the importance of disaster-preparedness - emergency kits, emergency responders in place, warning signs and labels, drills, 911, ...

Spiritually, a mark of wisdom is to prepare to avoid disaster, the wrath of God.

(Amos 4:11-12) "... prepare to meet your God"
(Matthew 25:1-4) "... but the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps"
(v13) "Watch therefore, for ... "
