BOOK OF JONAH

1. REVEALING THE POWER OF GOD

1. His omnipresence (everywhere present)

(Jonah 1:3) "But Jonah arose to flee to Tarshish from the presence of the Lord" (Proverbs 15:3) "The eyes of the Lord are in every place ..."

- 2. Over the elements.
 - (1:4) "But the Lord sent out a great wind on the sea ..."
 - (4:8) "And it happened, when the sun arose, that God prepared a vehement east wind ..."
- 3. Over the animals.
 - (1:17) "Now the Lord had prepared a great fish to swallow Jonah"
 - (2:10) "So the Lord spoke to the fish, and it vomited Jonah onto dry land"
 - (4:7) "But as morning dawned the next day God prepared a worm ... "
- 4. Over the preaching of His word.
 - (3:2) "Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and preach to it the message that I tell you"
 - (3:5) "So the people of Nineveh believed God"
 - (Isaiah 55:11) "So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; it shall not return to Me void, but it shall accomplish what I please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it"
- 5. Over plants.
 - (4:6) "And the Lord prepared a plant and made it to come up over Jonah"

2. REVEALING GOD'S CARE & CONCERN

- 1. God is angry and displeased with wickedness.
 - (1:2) "Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and cry out against it; for their wickedness has come up before me."
- 2. God may hear our prayers, no matter where we may be.
 - (2:1) "Then Jonah prayed to the Lord his God from the fish's belly"
- 3. God cares about His creation.
 - (4:11) "And should I not pity Nineveh"
 - (4:11) "and much livestock."

(Psalm 36:6) "... O Lord, You preserve man and beast"

(Matthew 10:29) "Are not two sparrows sold for a copper coin?

And not one of them falls to the ground apart from your Father's will"
