## THE JOY OF THE LORD

## INTRODUCTION

- (Phil. 4:4) "Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, Rejoice."
- God definitely wants us to be joyous (happy): (James 1:2) "My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials" so, where's the joy? (v3) "knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience."

Joy is a by-product, a consequence, a result of a completed task or being in a right relationship.

(Psalm 28:7) "the Lord is my strength and my shield. My heart trusted in Him, and I am helped; therefore, my heart greatly rejoices, and with my song I will praise Him."

(Psalm 5:11-12) "Let all those rejoice who put their trust in You ... "

## JOY IS THE RESULT OF THE FOLLOWING:

1. SALVATION - (Psalm 21:1) "... and in Your salvation how greatly shall he rejoice."

(Psalm 35:9) "My soul shall be joyful in the Lord; it shall **rejoice in His salvation"** (Romans 5:11) "but we also **rejoice in God** through our Lord Jesus Christ, through Whom we have now **received the reconciliation."** 

- 2. BELIEVING (1 Peter 1:3-9) "... begotten us again to a living hope ... to an inheritance ... who are kept by the power of God through faith for salvation ... in this you greatly rejoice ... yet believing, you rejoice with joy inexpressible ... the salvation of your souls."
- 3. (Luke 10:20) " ... REJOICE BECAUSE YOUR NAMES ARE WRITTEN IN HEAVEN"

  (Revelation 20:12, v15)

## 4. BEING IN THE KINGDOM (CHURCH)

(Romans 14:17) "for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and joy in the Holy Spirit."

Jesus defined entrance into the kingdom: (John 3:3-7) "you must be born again"

- 5. HOPE (Romans 12:12) "rejoicing in hope ... "
- 6. HEAVEN (Matthew 25:23) "The Lord said to him, Well done, good and faithful servant ... Enter into the joy of your Lord."

(Psalm 30:5) "Weeping may endure for a night; but joy comes in the morning" (Psalm 126:5) "Those who sow in tears shall reap in joy." Joy here and a greater joy hereafter.
