## NAMES FOR US (CHURCH) continued

## INTRODUCTION

**Review:** Biblically, there is not one "official name" used for the N.T. church.

Previous lessons noted: (Acts 9:1) "this way" (Acts 2:47) "the church" (Romans 16:16) "churches of Christ" (1 Cor. 1:2) "the church of God" (Hebrews 12:23) "church of the firstborn" (Colossians 1:13) "the kingdom of the Son of His love"

1. FLOCK OF GOD - (1 Peter 5:1-4) "the elders who are among you ... shepherd the flock of God which is among you ... examples to the flock ... and when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the crown of glory that does not fade away"

(Acts 20:28-30) "... and to all the flock ... to shepherd the church of God ... the flock ... "

(Luke 12:32) "Do not fear, **little flock**, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you **the kingdom**" Also in (John 10:11 and v16)

O.T. references: (Psalm 23:1; Micah 7:14; Ezekiel 34:11, v15, v22, v31)

2. ISRAEL OF GOD - (Galatians 6:16) " ... and upon the Israel of God"

Other words in the text help us to understand this phrase: "in Christ Jesus" "neither circumcision nor un-circumcision" "but a new creation" "as many as walk according to this rule"

Similar topic is noted in: (Romans 2:28-29; Philippians 3:2-3; Galatians 3:7)

3. BODY - (Colossians 1:18) "And he is the head of the body, the church"

(Ephesians 1:22-23) "... head over all things to the church, which is His body"
(3:6) "... be fellow-heirs, of the same body ... " (4:11-13) "of the body of Christ"
(5:23-24) "also Christ is head of the church, and He is the savior of the body.
Therefore, just as the church is subject to Christ ... "

(Romans 12:4-6) "For as we have many members in **one body ...**" see (Eph. 4:4

(1 Corinthians 12:12-27) read it!

4. PEOPLE OF GOD - (1 Peter 2:9-10) " ... His own special people ... once were not a people but are now the people of God ... obtained mercy"

"called out of darkness" - (2 Thess. 2:14 and Col. 1:13)

"proclaim the praises of Him" - (Hebrews 13:15-16 and Psalm 107:2)
