PLANTING HEBREW "LET US"

(Hebrews 10:19-31)

INTRODUCTION - we are familiar with the work involved in planting a garden.

The same effort, attention, is needed in planting and cultivating the Christian life.

In each we anticipate growth: (Romans 6:3-4; 1 Peter 2:1-2; 2 Peter 3:18; Galatians 6:7)

- 1. (4:1) "... let us fear ..." be terrified to miss "entering His rest" (heaven).
- 2. (4:11) "Let us be diligent to enter that rest" persistent effort; tireless activity; work at it.
- 3. (4:14) "... let us hold fast our confession" get a grip; hang on for dear life; squeeze.
- 4. (4:16) "Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace ..." we have a "time of need" for "grace" "mercy" and "help" that's provided from the "throne of grace."
- 5. (6:1) " ... let us go on to perfection ("maturity") ... " growth is expected.
- 6. (10:22) "Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith ... " (Matt. 15:7-10)
- 7. (10:23) "Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering ..." (Titus 1:2)
- 8. (10:25) "And let us consider one another ... " look around you.
- 9. (12:1) "... let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us ... "
- 10. (12:1) " ... and let us <u>run</u> with patience the race that is set before us" (v2) "Looking to Jesus" (v3) "For consider Him"
- 11. (12:28) " ... let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably ... "
- 12. (13:13 14) "Therefore, let us go forth to Him, outside the camp, bearing His reproach. For here we have no continuing city, but we seek the one to come."
- 13. (13:15 16) "Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God ... But do not forget to do good and to share, for with such sacrifices God is well pleased."
- CLOSE this "let us" is a must in our spiritual diet. Enjoy the feast.
