INTRODUCTION: J.B. Phillips translated (Romans 12:2) "Don't let the world around you squeeze you into its own mold"

(John 17:14-17) "... they are not of the world ... I do not pray that You should take them out of the world, but that You should keep them from the evil one. They are not of the world ... "

The "world" to which we are <u>not</u> to be molded is the sinful behavior of its people, and it is defined in the verses of each point of this lesson.

1. (Romans 12:1-2) (v2) "Be not conformed ("fashioned") to this world"

"not conformed" - don't copy that which is opposed to Godliness.
"but be transformed" - make a change that involves body and mind.
"present your bodies" - in sacrificial living; in service designed by God; measure up to God's expectation; and recognize this as the right course of action.
"by the renewing of your mind" - a reasonable response based on evidence.

2. (1 John 2:15-17) (v15) "Do not love the world or the things of the world ... and the world is passing away ... but he who does the will of God abides forever."

"if anyone loves the world" - attached to worldly attitudes and actions opposing God.

"the love of the Father is not in him" - can't have it both ways. Note (Matt. 6:24)

(Matthew 22:36) "What is the great commandment ...?

"for all that is in the world ... is not of the Father" - worldly lusts that are mentioned.

3. (2 Corinthians 6:16-18) (v17) "therefore, come ye out from among them and be separate, says the Lord"

The reason for this right action: (v16) "for you are the temple of the living God"

Blessings are associated with this right action: "I will dwell in them" "walk among them"

"be their God" "they shall be My people" "I will receive you" "I will be a Father
to you" "you shall be My sons and daughters" "says the Lord Almighty"

4. (Ephesians 5:6-12) (v7) "do not be partakers with them" (v11) "and have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness"

The admonition is: "you were once darkness, but now are light in the Lord;" so do not go back and participate in the old ways of worldly living.

(Ephesians 4:17) "you should no longer walk as the rest of the Gentiles walk"

(v20) "you have not so learned Christ" (v22) "put off" (v24) "put on"

- 5. (James 1:27) "Pure and undefiled religion before God the Father is this ... to keep one-self unspotted from the world" enjoy clean living.
- 6. (James 4:4) "Adulterers and adulteresses! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? ... to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God"
