A WONDERFUL SAVIOR

(Matthew 1:18-25)

INTRODUCTION - What is it that makes Jesus so wonderful, distinctive, set apart?

1. THE MANNER OF HIS BIRTH: (text)

This puts Jesus in a class by Himself.

An earthly child with a heavenly Father, a heavenly child with an earthly mother.

2. HE LIVED A WONDERFUL LIFE

(Hebrews 4:15) "was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin." Pilate concluded: (Luke 23:4) "I find no fault in this Man." (1 Peter 2:22) "Who committed no sin, nor was deceit found in His mouth." No one ever has lived, is living, nor will ever live like that.

3. HE DIED A VICARIOUS DEATH

"Vicarious" - serving instead of someone else; a Divine substitute.
(Romans 5:6-8) " ... Christ died for the ungodly ... Christ died for us."
(1 John 4:10) " ... and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins."

4. HIS PURPOSE-FILLED RESURRECTION

(Romans 4:25) "Who was delivered for our offenses, and was raised for our justification" (1 Cor. 15:17) "and if Christ is not risen, your faith is futile; you are yet in your sins."
