DEFINING TYPES OF SIN

(James 2:1-9)

INTRODUCTION

No one is exempt from sin: (Romans 3:10 "none righteous" (v23) "for all have sinned"

There is hope: (Matthew 1:21) "... Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins."

"Sin" - "to miss the mark;" "fall short of the glory of God"

(Psalm 51:1) "... blot out my transgressions"

(v2) "Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin"

(John 18:38) "Pilate said ... I find no fault in Him at all"

ILLUSTRATING TYPES OF SINS

1. OMIT, I NEGLECTED SOMETHING

(James 4:17) "Therefore, to him who knows to do good and does not do it, to him it is sin" "know to do good" - carries a responsibility to do it.

2. COMMIT, I DID THAT

(1 John 3:4) "Whoever commits sin also commits lawlessness, and sin is lawlessness." (James 2:9) "but if you show partiality, you commit sin, and are convicted by the law as transgressors"

(Galatians 5:19-21) "Now the works of the flesh are evident ... those who practice such ... "

.. 3. SIN THAT WILL "ENSNARE US"

(Hebrews 12:1) "... let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us" It's personal. It's the wrong-doing that is tempting to you, easily ensnares you.

4. SECRET SIN

(Psalm 19:12) "Who can understand his error? Cleanse me from secret faults" (Leviticus 5:17) "If a person sins, and commits any of these things ... though he does not know it, yet he is guilty, and shall bear his iniquity." (Ecclesiastes 12:14) "For God will bring every work into judgment, including every secret thing, whether good or evil"

5. PRESUMPTUOUS SINS

(Psalm 19:13) "Keep back Your servant from **presumptuous sins** ... great transgressions" (Numbers 15:30-31) "But the person who **does anything presumptuously** ... his guilt shall be upon him"

(Judges 16:20) "... said, I will go out as before, at other times, and shake myself free.

But he did not know that the Lord had departed from him"
