INTRODUCTION - the next two "fruit of the Spirit"

1. "KINDNESS"

1) Kindness defined - describes an attitude of goodness towards another person; showing or having a gentle considerate nature; good-hearted; willing to help others.

2) Characteristic of God:

(Psalm 31:21) "His marvelous kindness"
(Psalm 107:43) "the loving-kindness of the Lord"
(Psalm 117:1-2) "for His merciful kindness"
(Psalm 119:76) "Your merciful kindness"
(Ephesians 2:4-7) "of His great love ... grace ... in His kindness toward us ... "
(Titus 3:3-5) "when the kindness and love of God our Savior toward man appeared"

3) Characteristic of us, the "new man"

(Colossians 3:9-10) "since you have put off the old man with his deeds, and have put on the new man ... put on tender mercies, kindness, ..."
(Romans 12:10) "Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love"
(1 Corinthians 13:4) "Love suffers long and is kind"
(Ephesians 4:32) "And be kind to one another"

2. "GOODNESS"

1) Goodness defined - be upright and kind in our feeling and actions; do good; to bestow a benefit; charity; a deed that's becoming or fitting; profitable; gracious.

2) Characteristic of God:

(Romans 2:4) "the riches of His goodness ... the goodness of God"
(2 Thessalonians 1:11-12) "fulfill all the good pleasure of His goodness"
(Psalm 31:19) "how great is Your goodness"
(Psalm 107:8, v15, v21, v31) "give thanks to the Lord for His goodness"
(Psalm 136:1) "give thanks to the Lord, for He is good."

3) Characteristic of us:

(Ephesians 5 8-10) "Walk as children of light (for the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness, righteousness, and truth)"
(Titus 3:8) "maintain good works ... things are good and profitable to men"
(2 Corinthians 9:8) "have an abundance for every good work"
(Romans 12:21) "but overcome evil with good"
