INTRODUCTION

- (v9) "For this reason we also, since the day we heard it" In (v3-6) Paul reminds them of what he heard about them: "we heard of your faith" "your love" "the hope" "bringing forth fruit" and "you heard and knew the grace of God in truth"
- (v9) "... do not cease to pray for you" (Ephesians 6:19) "praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints."

THE CONTENT OF PAUL'S PRAYER

- 1. (v9) "that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding"
 - "Knowledge" (Psalm 119:7, v9, v12, v16, v33, v66)
 - "In all wisdom" put knowledge into practice; application.
 - "And spiritual understanding" (Psalm 119:27, v34, v73, v104, v125)
- 2. (v10) "that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him"
 - "Walk worthy" (Ephesians 4:1) "... beseech you to walk worthy ... "
 (Philippians 1:27) "Only let your conduct be worthy of the gospel of Christ ... "
 - **"Fully pleasing Him"** (2 Corinthians 5:9-10) "to be pleasing to Him" (Hebrews 13:16) "for with such sacrifices God is well pleased"
- "3. (v10) "Being fruitful in every good work"
 - (John 15:5) "... He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit ... "
 So much depends on our "abiding" in Jesus.
 - "Every good work" provides an opportunity to demonstrate "the fruit of the Spirit" (Galatians 5:22-25) "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace ..."
- 4. (v10) "And increasing in the knowledge of God" (2 Peter 1:2 and 3:17-18)
- 5. (v11) "Strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, for all patience and longsuffering with joy"
 - "His glorious power" (Ephesians 6:10-11, v13) "... be strong in the Lord ..."
 - "For patience and longsuffering" In struggles, I need the added strength of God's power.
- 6. (v12-14) "Giving thanks to the Father ..." "the inheritance" "delivered us" "conveyed us into the kingdom" "redemption" "the forgiveness of sins"
