# WORSHIP ASSEMBLY EVENTS

# INTRODUCTION

- "Events" items; something that takes place; actions; elements; something done.
- "Worship" giving praise and adoration to God; actions of homage or reverence; devotion.

  (Matthew 4:10) "you shall worship the Lord your God" (Rev. 22:9) "worship God"
- "Assembly" on the first day of the week the church comes together to worship God.

  (Hebrews 10:24-25: James 2:2)

The weekly worship assembly of the early church included these items:

1. PRAYER - (Colossians 1:3) "We give thanks to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you."

(Col. 3:17) - our prayers are to God and "through Him (Jesus)." (1 Timothy 2:5)

2. SINGING - (Ephesians 5:19-20) "speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing ..."

(Col. 3:16-17) "psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing ... "

### 3. COMMUNION / LORD'S SUPPER / BREAKING BREAD

(Acts 20:7) "on the first day of the week, when the disciples came together to break bread"

The "breaking bread" has its foundation at Jesus' "Last Supper." - (Matt. 26:26-30) (1 Corinthians 10:16-17; 1 Cor. 11:23-26)

# 4. COLLECTION / OFFERING

- (1 Cor. 16:1-2) "Now concerning the collection ... on the first day of the week ... "
- (2 Cor. 8:1-5) "... the churches of Macedonia ... according to their ability ... willing ... first they gave themselves to the Lord"

  (2 Cor. 9:7) "each one gave as he purposes in his heart ... cheerful giver"
- 5. SCRIPTURE READING (Nehemiah 8:1-3; Colossians 4:15-16)

#### 6. PRECHING THE WORD OF GOD

(Nehemiah 8:8) "So they read distinctly ... gave the sense ... understand the reading"

Paul did this in the synagogues: (Acts 17:2, 18:4; 18:19)

(2 Timothy 4:1-2) "preach the word ... convince ... and teaching"
