DO DAILY

(Acts 2:36 – 42, v47)

INTRODUCTION - “7 days without Christ makes **one weak.**”

Under the Old Law, there were daily sacrifices: (Exodus 30:7-8)

Under the New Testament, there's daily Christianity: (1 Peter 2:5; Romans 12:1)

1. DAILY PRAYER

(Psalm 55:17) “Evening and morning and at noon I will pray”

(Luke 11:3) “... give us this day our **daily bread** ... “

(1 Thessalonians 5:17) “pray without ceasing” - can't skip a day!

2. DAILY BIBLE STUDY

Moses gave a practical method of how to do this: (Deuteronomy 6:6-9)

For us: (Acts 17:11) “they received the word with all readiness, and

searched the Scriptures daily to find out whether these things were so.”

(1 Thessalonians 5:21) “Test all things, hold fast what is good”

(2 Timothy 2:15) “Be diligent (“study”) to present yourself approved to God”

3. DAILY TEACHING

(Luke 19:47-48) “And He (“Jesus”) was **teaching daily** in the temple ... “

(Acts 5:42) “**And daily** in the temple, and in every house,

they did not cease teaching and preaching Jesus as the Christ.”

(Acts 20:31) “... I did not cease to warn everyone **night and day** with tears”

4. DAILY EXHORTATION

(Hebrews 3:12-13) “... **but exhort one another daily** ... “

(1 Thessalonians 5:14) “comfort the faint-hearted, uphold the weak”

5. DAILY CROSS-BEARING

(Luke 9:23) “If anyone desire to come after Me, let him deny himself,
and **take up his cross daily**, and follow Me.” Note (Luke 14:27)

CLOSE - You are writing a gospel, a chapter each day,
By the deeds that you do, and the words that you say.
Men read what you write, whether faulty or true,
Say, what is the gospel according to you?
