7 SINS AGAINST THE SPIRIT

(Mark 3:22-30)

INTRODUCTION

You and I were given the "gift of the Holy Spirit" when we were baptized: (Acts 2:38-39) It's confirmed in Scripture: (Romans 8:9, v11; 1 Corinthians 6:19-20; 1 John 3:24 and 4:13)

1. (Matthew 12:31-32; Mark 3:28-30) "WHO BLASPHEMES AGAINST THE HOLY SPIRIT"

Defined in the text: (Mark 3:30) "because they said, He has an unclean spirit"

(Matthew 12:32) "speaks against the Holy Spirit"

"Blaspheme" - to rail against; revile; to speak contemptuously of the Divine.

For us "in the age to come," meaning the NT era, it's to speak against the inspired message.

It is not a one time action; rather, a way of life that rejects God's delivered way of salvation in Christ and will be "subject to eternal condemnation" (Mark 3:29).

Reference: (Hebrews 1:1-2; John 12:48-50, 14:25-26, 16:5-15; 2 Timothy 3:14-17)

2. (Acts 5:3) "TO <u>LIE TO</u> THE HOLY SPIRIT" (v4) "NOT LIED TO MEN BUT TO GOD" (v11) "TO TEST THE SPIRIT OF THE LORD"

It's a lesson on hypocrisy, pretense, professing what you are not, being two-faced. It will not go undetected.

3. (Acts 7:51) "YOU ALWAYS RESIST THE HOLY SPIRIT"

"Resist" - (v53) "received the law ... and not kept it;" to fight against the truth; rebel.

4. (Galatians 5:16-17) "FOR THE FLESH LUSTS AGAINST THE SPIRIT ... CONTRARY"

Since "flesh" and "Spirit" are "contrary to one another," we are admonished in (v16) "walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh." (Romans 13:14) "... make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts."

5. (Ephesians 4:30) "DO NOT GRIEVE THE HOLY SPIRIT OF GOD"

(v25-32) reveals attitudes and actions that "grieve" the indwelling Holy Spirit "by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption." (see Ephesians 1:13-14)

6. (1 Thessalonians 5:19) "DO NOT QUENCH THE SPIRIT"

(Luke 8:11) "the seed is the word of God" (v14) "... are those who, when they have heard, go out and are choked with cares, riches, and pleasures of life, and bring no fruit to maturity." Don't smother the Spirit within you.

7. (Hebrews 10:26-31) (v29) "... AND INSULTED THE SPIRIT OF GRACE"

It includes those who **(v26)** "sin willfully," and perhaps think there's another plan. (John 14:6) There's only one way, and be afraid to miss it.
