10 PLAGUES AND 4 COMPROMISES

9/29/2019 - Supplement to Bible Class Lesson on the Exodus.

- 1. (7:20-21) "And all the waters that were in the river were turned to blood ... fish died ... stank ... could not drink the water ... blood throughout all the land ... "
- 2. (8:5-6) "and the frogs came up and covered the land of Egypt"
- 3. (8:16-17) "All the dust of the land became lice throughout all the land of Egypt"
 - (v22) "I will set apart the land of Goshen, in which my people dwell, that no swarm of flies shall be there, in order that you may know that I am the Lord in the midst of the land"
- 4. (8:24) "The land was corrupted because of the swarms of flies"
 - (v25) "Go, sacrifice to your God in the land"
 - (v28) "So Pharaoh said, I will let you go ... only you shall not go very far away"
- 5. (9:3-4) "behold, the hand of the Lord will be on your cattle in the field, ...horses, ...donkeys, ...camels, ...oxen, ...sheep, a very severe pestilence.
 And the Lord will make a difference between the livestock of Israel and the livestock of Egypt. So nothing shall die of all that belongs to the children of Israel"
- 6. (9:8-9) "ashes ... scatter it ... and it will become fine dust in the land of Egypt, and it will cause boils that break out in sores on man and beast throughout all the land of Egypt"
- 7. (9:22) "Stretch out your hand toward heaven, that there may be hail in all the land of Egypt"
 - (10:11) "Go now, you who are men, and serve the Lord"
- 8. (10:13-15) "When it was morning, the east wind brought the locusts ... very severe ... "
- 9. (10:22) "So Moses stretched out his hand toward heaven, and there was thick darkness in all the land of Egypt for three days ... but the children of Israel had light in their dwellings"
 - (v24) "Then Pharaoh called to Moses and said, Go, serve the Lord, only let your flocks and your herds be kept back. Let your little ones also go with you."
- 10. (11:4-5) "Moses said, Thus says the Lord: About midnight I will go out into the midst of Egypt, and all the firstborn in the land of Egypt shall die, from the firstborn of Pharaoh who sits on his throne, even to the firstborn of the female servant who is behind the hand-mill, and all the firstborn of the animals."
 - (12:13) "And when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be on you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt"
