RESURRECTION: ANSWERING OBJECTIONS

(John 19:31 - 20:10)

INTRODUCTION

Other scripture references to the resurrection story: (Matthew 28:1-8; Mark 16:1-8; Luke 24:1-12; Acts 2:22-24; 1 Corinthians 15:1-8)

Skeptic - scoffer; mocker; non-believer; doubter; the questioner; suspicious; one seeking answers to the truth of something.

1. THE DISCIPLES STOLE THE BODY

(Matthew 28:11-15) - this text records the guards going to the chief priests to inform them about the empty tomb (resurrection), and they bribed the guard to tell this hoax.

Answer - 1) If they were asleep when it happened, how would they know who stole the body?

- 2) The guards would incur a death penalty for a prisoner or a body to escape their guard.
- 3) Would the disciples go through martyrdom for an untruth?
- 4) (John 20:5-8) Robbers, in a hurry to do their deed, would not be tidy.

2. JOSEPH & NICODEMUS REMOVED THE BODY TO A DIFFERENT BURIAL SITE

- Answer 1) When would they have done that deed? Violate the Sabbath, too?
 - 2) Could two men slip past a guarded tomb to commit the deed?
 - 3) (Luke 23:50) notes Joseph's character, and he would not perpetuate a hoax.

3. THE WOMEN WENT TO THE WRONG TOMB ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE WEEK

- Answer 1) (Luke 23:54-56) These women were eye-witnesses to the burial, and they could not have forgotten the burial site over the weekend.
 - 2) (John 19:41) The burial site was easily identified.
 - 3) Perhaps it's possible for one person to get lost, but not a small group.

4. THE APPEARANCES OF JESUS AFTER THE RESURRECTION WERE ILLUSIONS OR HALLUCINATIONS BY THE WITNESSES

Answer - 1) Perhaps possible if only a few witnesses; however, the witnesses are too many for it to be a deception: (1 Cor. 15:5-8) records Peter, the 12, over 500 at once, James, all the apostles, and Paul. (Luke 24:18) Cleopas and a companion on the way to Emmaus. (Acts 1:3-11) a large audience gathered to witness Jesus' ascension 40 days after His resurrection.

2) Why would the "hallucinations" stop after 40 days? No record of Jesus being said to be seen on earth after His ascension.

5. THE SWOON THEORY

Answer - the scriptures affirm Jesus' death: (John 19:31-37; Mark 15:44-45; Luke 23:46) and (John 19:39-40)
