(Matthew 26:28) "... for this is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for remission of sins" (Hebrews 9:23) "... and without the shedding of blood there is no remission"

1. THE OLD TESTAMENT STORY OF BLOOD

- 2. THE NEW TESTAMENT STORY OF BLOOD Jesus' blood (death) ends all requirements for blood sacrifices that were required under the Old Testament.

(Mathew 26:27-28) "... for this is My blood of the new covenant ... remission of sins" (John 19:31-37) (v34) "But one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and immediately blood and water came out ... scripture should be fulfilled ... " (Romans 6:10) "For the death that He died, He died to sin once for all ... " (1 Corinthians 15:3-4) "... that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures." (Galatians 1:3-5) "... our Lord Jesus Christ, who gave Himself for our sins ... " (1 Peter 2:24) "who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree ... " (1 John 1:7) "... and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin." (Revelation 5:9) "... For You were slain, and have redeemed us to God by Your blood out of every tribe and tongue and people and nations."

3. SUMMARY OF ATONEMENT FOR SINS

- 1) Old Testament Involved blood of animals, sacrifices made throughout their generations, sacrifices were many and made different times during the years, sacrifices could not take away sins, the law made nothing perfect, priests were prevented by death from continuing, law was faulty, priests offered sacrifices for their own sins also, law was a shadow of things to come.
