1. (v24-29) PAUL'S SACRIFICIAL SERVICE FOR CHRIST

- 1) (v24) "I now rejoice in my sufferings for you" ready to suffer. (2 Timothy 3:12; 1 Peter 4:12-13)
 - "and fill up in my flesh what is lacking in the afflictions of Christ"
 It does not mean something was lacking in the redemptive sacrifice of Christ,

 Jesus' sacrifice paid it all.

It does mean there's a close identification between Christ and the church through suffering. (1 Peter 4:12) "you partake of Christ's sufferings" "for the sake of His body, which is the church" - our sufferings accompany His.

- 2) (v25) "I became a minister" ready to minister.

 This verse takes us back to Ananias and Saul: (Acts 9:15-16).

 (v26-27) "the mystery" (Ephesians 3:1, v4-5, v7-8)
- 3) (v28) "Him we preach" ready to preach.

 "Him" (Acts 4:12 "Nor is there salvation in any other ... "

 "Warning every man and teaching every man" (2:8 and 3:16)

 "That we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus" (Romans 8:1)
- 4) (v29) "To this end, I also labor" ready to toil and serve.
 (1 Thessalonians 2:9 and 1 Timothy 4:10)

2. (2:1-7) I'M NOT THERE, BUT HERE IS MY WRITTEN CARE & CONCERN

- 1) (v2) "That their hearts may be encouraged" written messages do that!
 Written messages may be kept and read over and over.
- 2) (v2) "Being knit together in love" Merriam-Webster: "to link firmly or closely; to form a fabric by interlacing yarn or thread in connected loops with needles."
- 3) (v2) "And attaining to all riches of the full assurance ..."
 (v3) "In whom are hidden all the treasures ..."

 (2 Timothy 1:11-12) "... I know whom I have believed ..."
 - (2 Timothy 1:11-12) "... I know whom I have believed ..." (1 John 5:13) "... that you may know that you have eternal life ..."
- 4) (v4) "deceive you with persuasive words" (Galatians 1:6-9)
- 5) (v5) "I am with you in spirit, rejoicing ..." (3 John v4)
- 6) (v6-7) "As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him" "Rooted ... built up in Him ... established ... thanksgiving"
