FOUR DIMENSIONS OF CHRIST'S LOVE

(Ephesians 3:14-21)

- INTRODUCTION (v17-18) "that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height to know the love of Christ ... "
- "Love" an attitude and action of one that provides a way to benefit others.
- "Comprehend" to catch hold of; understand; to grasp mentally; learn; to gain the lenowledge of something.
- (1 John 4:9) "In this the love of God was manifested toward us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him"
- Hymn #133 The Love of God v3 "Could we with ink ... parchment ... a quill ... a scribe ... to write the love of God above ... "
- The Word of God (2 Timothy 3:16) and our hymns (Colossians 3:16) are included in this lesson to aid us in comprehension of Christ's love.

THE 4 DIMENSIONS OF CHRIST'S LOVE

1. "WIDTH" - its breadth; the gospel is for all; it's world-wide in invitation.

Christ's love and invitation is extended to a world of people; none excluded.

(Mark 16:15-16) "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature.

he who believes and is baptized will be saved" Note also (Acts 10:35)

2. "LENGTH" - God, Christ, went to great lengths to demonstrate this love.

(John 3:16 and 15:13; Matthew 20:17-19) Hymn #386 He Loves Me

3. "DEPTH" - the love (grace) of Christ reaches me; it reaches all of us; lifts us up!

(Isaiah 1:18; Hebrews 7:25; Romans 5:8-9; Psalm 40:2-3) Hymn #453 Love Lifted Me v1 and 3

4. "HEIGHT" - His love enables us to set our sights on heaven; takes us to heaven.

(Philippians 1:14-15; Colossians 3:1-2; John 14:1-3) Hymn #539 Higher Ground vl and 4

CLOSE - We cannot doubt Christ's love for us, and He said, in (John 14:15) "If you love Me, keep My commandments."
