YES, GOD IS ABLE TO DO THAT

(Ephesians 3:14-21)

INTRODUCTION

"Able" - capable; competent; can do; efficient; accomplished.

(Daniel 3:15-18, v28) "... our God whom we serve is able to deliver us ... "

(Daniel 6:19-20) "... has your God, whom you serve continually, been able to deliver you ...?" (v22) "My God sent His angel and shut the lions' mouths, so that they have not hurt me."

In this lesson, we will note what God is "able" to do in your life and mine.

1. (Hebrews 7:25) "... also He ("Jesus") is able to save to the uttermost those who come to God"

"Uttermost" - the worst; those at the farthest limit; those at the bottom. It's Jesus' purpose in coming: (Matthew 1:21; Hebrews 5:8)

2. (Hebrews 2:17-18) "... For in that He Himself has suffered, being tempted, He is able to aid those who are tempted."

(Hebrews 4:15) "... was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin" (2 Peter 2:9) "The Lord knows how to deliver the godly out of temptation" (Matthew 4:1-11) Jesus answered His temptations with "It is written ..."

3. (Jude v24) "Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling ... "

(1 Corinthians 10:12-13) "... with the temptation will also make the way of escape ... " (Psalm 119:11) "Thy word have I hid in my heart, that I might not sin against You"

4. (Acts 20:32) "I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and give you an inheritance ... "

"Build you up" - be strengthened; be fortified; sturdy; encouraged.

(2 Timothy 3:15) "the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus."

(v16) "All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable ... "

5. (Romans 4:20-21) "... what He had promised He was also able to perform"

"To perform" - do; accomplish; finish; complete; fulfill; achieve. (Titus 1:2) "... which God, who cannot lie, promised before time began"

- 6. (2 Timothy 1:12) "... am persuaded that He is able to keep what I have committed to Him"
- 7. (Ephesians 3:20-21) "Now to Him who is able to do exceeding abundantly above all ... to Him be glory in the church ... forever and ever. Amen."
