"I CHANGE NOT"

INTRODUCTION: (Malachi 3:6) "For I am the Lord, I do not change"

1. WE CHANGE - "Change" - become different; alteration; mutation; not fixed.

1) **In life** - from birth to old age; in our thinking (change our mind).

2) **In becoming a Christian.**

(Acts 3:19-20) "Repent therefore, and **be converted** ... "

"**Converted**" - to change in nature or form; about-face; reversal.

(Romans 12:1-2) "And **do not be conformed** to this world, but **be transformed** by the renewing of your mind ... "

"**Conformed**" - to be like that; to fit-in with; harmonize with.

"**Transformed**" - to change; convert; transfigure; mutate.

(Ephesians 4:20-24) "that you put off ... that you put on ... "

3) **In the second-coming.**

(1 Corinthians 15:50-53) "but we shall all be changed ... be changed."

2. GOD DOES NOT CHANGE

(James 1:17) " ... the Father of lights, with whom there is **no variation** ... "

"**Variation**" - changeable; variable; diverseness

(Psalm 102:25-27) " ... they will all grow old like a garment ... and they will be changed. **But You are the same** ... "

God is not subject to an age-cycle; does not grow, develop, or mature.

(Hebrews 6:17-18) " ... the **immutability of His counsel** ... "

"**Immutability**" - does not mutate; is un-changing and unchangeable.

3. SO, TO ME, THIS MEANS THAT ... (make it personable)

1) **I can trust God's Word** - (Titus 1:2) (Psalm 50:15) (Proverbs 3:6) (Isaiah 41:10) (Romans 1:16) (Acts 2:38) (Revelation 2:10)

2) **I trust that God will give me "daily bread"** - (Matthew 6:11)

3) **I trust (believe) that there's a place called heaven** - (John 14:1-3)
